General Information: Profuse, exceptionally large blossoms make superior cut flowers. A classic beauty for butterfly gardens or combined with other perennials such as iris, poppy, daylily or yarrow. Cut faded flower stems down to the next visible bud to promote rebloom.

Grower Information:

Single, pure white flowers with yellow centers are 3 in. (8 cm) across, over dark green leaves.
