**Plant Details:**

**Scientific Name:** *Leucanthemum x superbum*

**Common Name:** Shasta Daisy

**Hardiness Zone:** 5a - 8b

**Hardiness Degree:** -30°F (-34.4°C)

**Blooming Season:** Late Summer, Summer

**Plant Habit:** Mounded, Upright

**Characteristics:** Attracts Butterflies

**General Information:** Profuse, exceptionally large blossoms make superior cut flowers. A classic beauty for butterfly gardens or combined with other perennials such as iris, poppy, daylily or yarrow. Cut faded flower stems down to the next visible bud to promote rebloom.

**Grower Information:**

Single, pure white flowers with yellow centers are 3 in. (8 cm) across, over dark green leaves.
